Celebration of Kisan Diwas

Popularly known as Kisan Diwas, the National Farmers' Day is a national occasion observed on 23 December every year. National Farmers' Day is celebrated in the honour of the fifth Prime Minister of India, Shri Chaudhary Charan Singh. The methods of releasing the parasitoids were also demonstrated for the benefit of the farmers.
