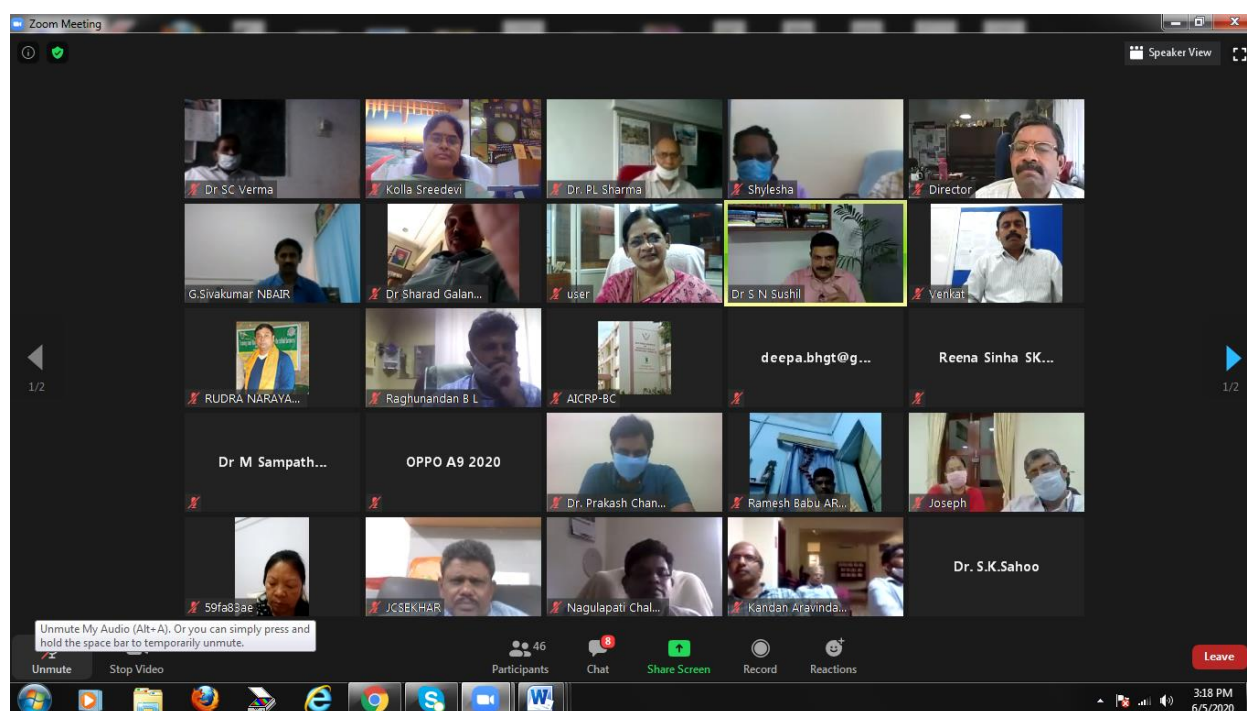
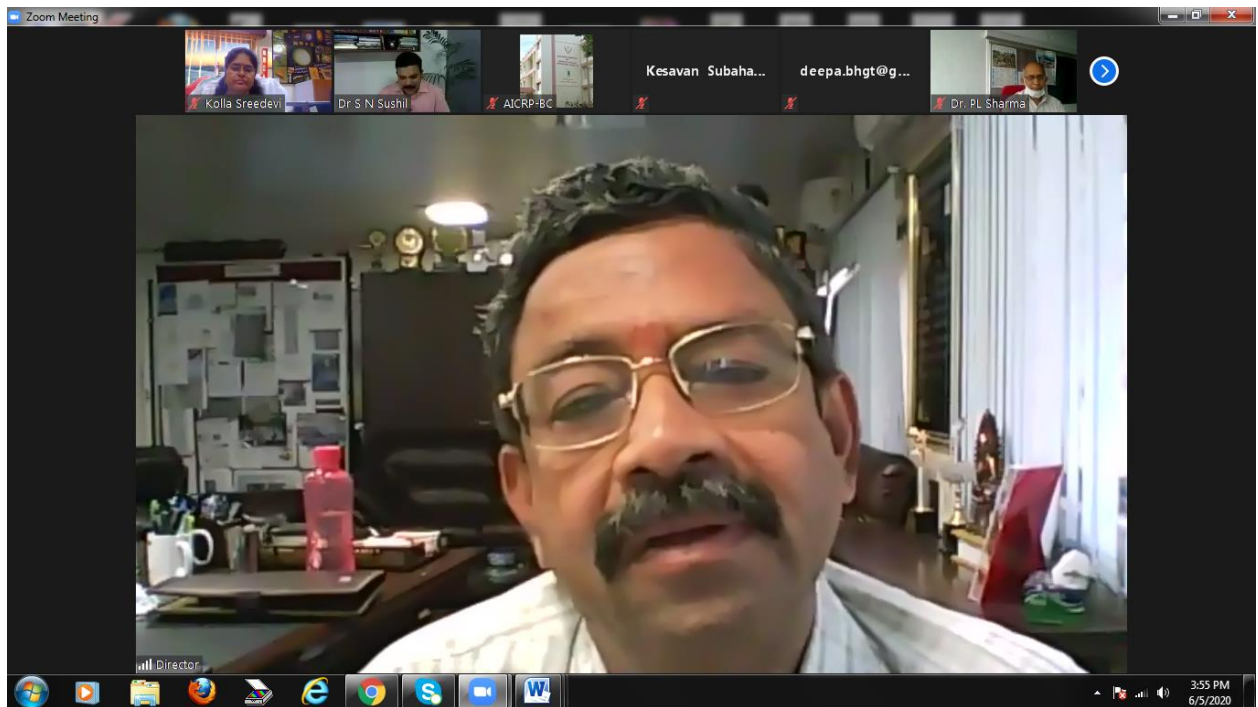


Virtual meet on Desert Locust

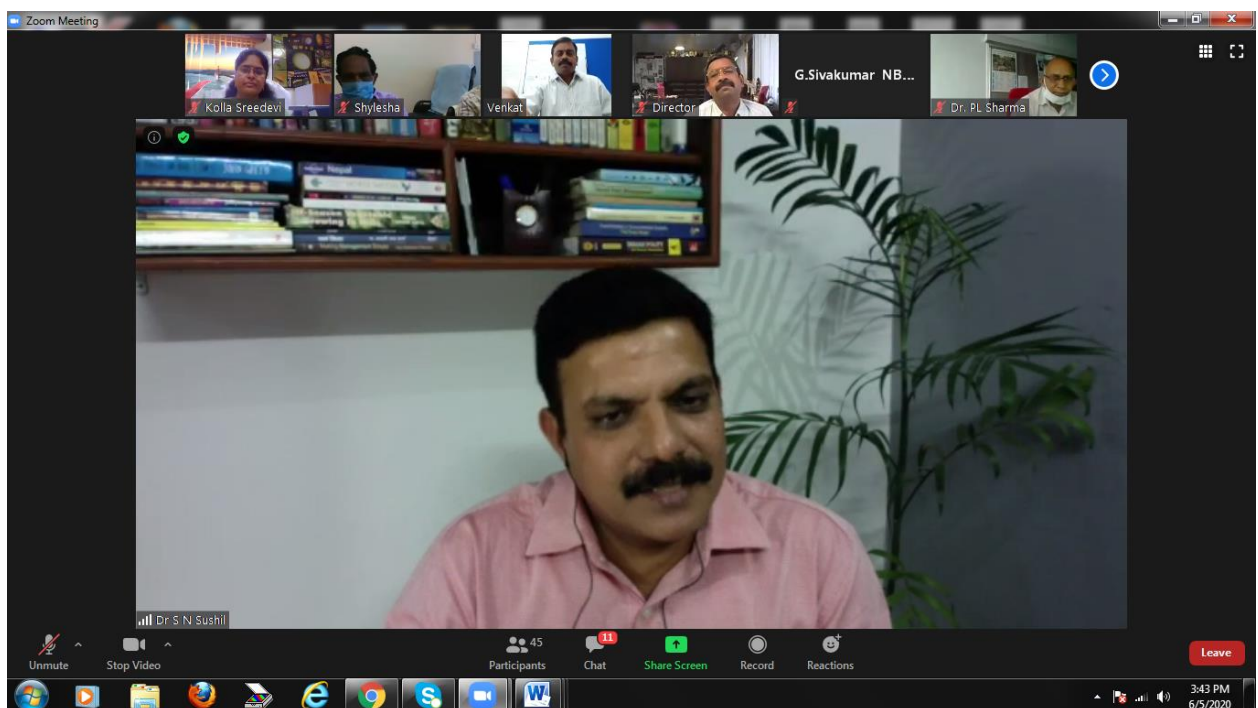
