Event Conducted	SafaiMitra Samman Waste to wealth workshop:
Brief Description of the event	On 1 October 2024 under “Swachhta Hi Sewa” campaign 2024, SafaiMitra Samman: Waste to Wealth Workshop was organized at ICAR-NBAIR, Bengaluru, Karnataka Under the programme, SafaiMitra/ sanitation workers were trained on creating products made of up recycled materials to champion the principles of ‘Reduce, Reuse, Recycle’. Sanitation workers were trained on utilization of Organic wastes emanating from household, plantations and agricultural farms for bioconversion in to nutrient rich compost and by product black soldier fly larvae as feed. Recycling of wastes like wood, carton boxes etc. for rearing of black soldier fly larvae for bioconversion of organic waste was also demonstrated. Awareness was also created for reducing of use of non-biodegradable materials like plastic and its hazards in environment. Experiences of sanitation workers were also shared in the workshop. Dr. Mahesh Yandigeri conducted programme on reuse and recycling of organic wastes. Dr. Gundappa and Dr. Amala shared their views on reducing use of plastic and also recycling of organic wastes in to re-utilizable forms. Dr. Dr. B.K. Chaubey shared his view on using coconut fronds for making broomsticks and Dr. K. Selvaraj explained on production of coco peat from coconut wastes. Dr. B. K. Chaubey and Mr. Yogesh Kaswan assisted in arranging the workshop and storytelling sessions on experiences of sanitation workers.
